HIS 275 - AMERICAN MILITARY HISTORY

The History Department of Red Rocks Community College will offer a three credit course for the 2014 Fall Semester, <u>HIS 275: American Military History</u>. The course will be held on the Lakewood Campus, <u>Mondays and Wednesdays</u>, 4:30 – 5:45 pm. The course will cover American military topics ranging from the first colonial militia unit of 1636 to current operations in Afghanistan. The primary focus of the course will be from the American soldier, Marine, sailor, and airman perspective. The course has one textbook, with selected readings from books on reserve in the Red Rocks Library.



The student will use primary and secondary sources for a research paper, to include official sources from the former War Department or the current Department of Defense. Guest speakers will present on a variety of topics throughout the course. All students are encouraged to consider a different perspective on American history.
