#### Reporting Emergencies to Campus Police

To ensure rapid response to any perceived emergency, please call 911 from any campus phone or dial extension 6394 to reach dispatch immediately.

Please do not call any other campus police phone number before calling dispatch as this will delay the response time.

#### For Medical emergencies please provide:

- ★ The exact location of the emergency (room number and / or area of building)
- ★ What the nature of the emergency is?  
Example: Person is having a seizure
- ★ Your name and phone number
- ★ Please stay on the line with dispatch until emergency personnel arrive
- ★ Any changes to the persons condition while you are on the line with us

#### For any perceived threats or aggressive behavior:

- ★ The exact location
  - ★ What is the person(s) doing? Are they still there?
  - ★ Your name and phone number
  - ★ Is this going on now?
  - ★ Are any weapons involved/or any weapons visible?
  - ★ What does the person (s) look like? (gender, race, clothing, distinguishing features)
- This is very important in case the person leaves your area before our officers arrive.**
- ★ If possible, please stay on the line with dispatch until Campus Police arrives

As professional 911 dispatchers, we are trained to handle all emergency calls. Please do not hesitate to contact us for any perceived threat or suspicious person / incidents.
