UNDERSTANDING ISLAM

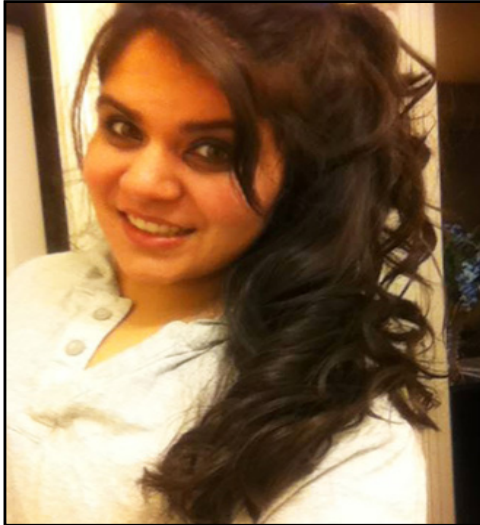
