

Q. Do you do pregnancy tests? A. The student health clinic can offer pregnancy testing for \$5. We can accept walk-ins but do ask that you schedule an appointment if you have any additional questions. We can offer birth control at the clinic also.

Summer Students: Funding your education doesn't have to be difficult or mysterious. You do not have to attend full time to qualify for financial aid. In fact, some students receive a grant (free money) for only one-half credit hour! As summer approaches, the Financial Aid Office (FAO) encourages you to contact us with any questions.
