Eligibility: In order to be granted faculty emeritus status, a faculty member must:

- Have made contributions to the College which are generally accepted as resulting in a significant contribution, advancement, or positive impact to the College.
- Have retired with full professor rank and with a minimum of fifteen years of full-time service with Red Rocks Community College.
- Have received a rating at the "commendable" or "exceeds expectations" level, or better, for a minimum of eight years, as certified by the candidate.

Nominations are encouraged from *any member of the College community* who believes that an individual may be qualified. Self-nominations are accepted. Each nomination should include a list of accomplishments and examples that demonstrate the fulfillment of criteria established for the designation of faculty emeritus.
