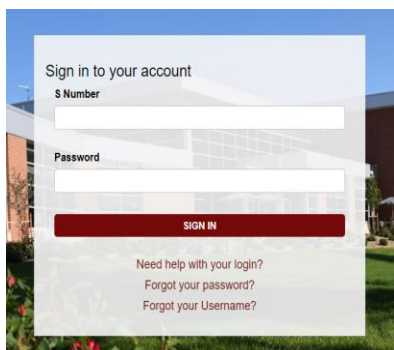

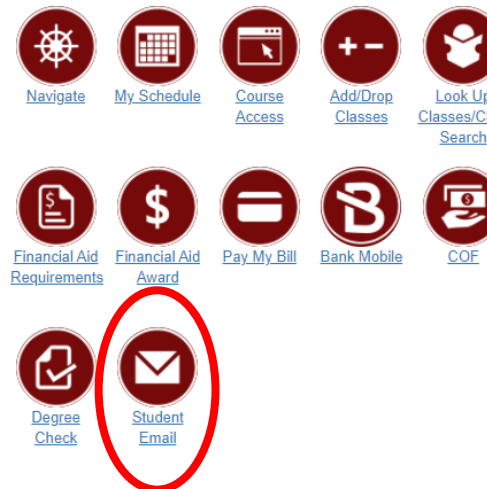

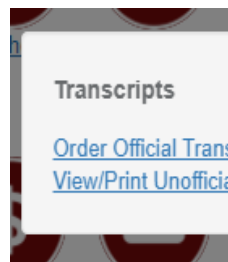

### **Associate of Arts (AA)**

Built for transferability to 4-year colleges and universities

Examples: Education, business, fine arts, political science, counseling, communications, etc.

### **Associate of Science (AS)**

Built for transfer to 4-year colleges and universities

Examples: mathematics, science, engineering, etc.



### **Associate of Applied Science (AAS)**

Prepares students for entry-level employment through a career-oriented program of study

Firefighting, HVAC, Graphic Design, Culinary Arts, etc.

### **Certificates**

Usually <30 credit hours  
Sometimes “stackable” and can fit into an AAS

Ex: Nurse Aid, Police Officer, Emergency Medical Technician (EMT), Lutheran Social Services, etc.
