

An important message from Red Rocks Community College

This semester, you are registered for a RRCC class through your high school and the Concurrent Enrollment program. Our records indicate you have not established a College Opportunity Fund (COF) account. The College Opportunity Fund contributes \$116 per credit hour towards tuition.

Even though you are concurrently enrolled through your high school, you still need to complete this process. Your school district will cover the tuition cost, but NOT the COF portion. If you do not complete this step, you will be responsible for the \$116 per credit stipend.

Please follow the instructions below to create your COF account:

1. Go to: <https://cof.college-assist.org/>
2. Click on **Apply Now** – Follow the directions for creating a ‘stipend’ account.
3. If you do not have a social security number or do not wish to provide one, you can select this option on the application (drop down arrow). *IMPORTANT: If you choose this option a unique College Opportunity Fund (COF) identification number will be assigned to you at the end of this application AND you will be required to give this number to each college you attend in order to receive this funding.*
