

Red Rocks Community College Application Instructions



Already have an RRCC S#?

You may not need to complete the RRCC online application. Please contact RRCC for assistance retrieving your student ID number (303) 914-6600.

- Go to the Red Rocks homepage www.rrcc.edu
- Click on the “**Apply**” link at the top of the page
- Click Concurrent Enrollment box
 - Click the “**CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT**” button
- Click on “**APPLY NOW**”
- Enter your personal information to create a profile
- Then, log back into your account
- Select **Fall 2024** as your Anticipated Entry Term
- Create a Username and Password. Write the information down for future use.
- Click “**Create Account**”
- Authenticate your account by checking your email and clicking on **Confirm Your Email**.
- Once in your account/profile select “**Apply Online**” in the top menu bar
- Click on the “**Start New Undergraduate Application**”
- Make sure it says **Fall 2024** as your Anticipated Entry Term. If not, enter it as a different term. Click on “**Complete Selected Application**”

Note: Make sure you answer all questions with a red*asterisk beside them. Make sure you use the correct capitalization and punctuation marks and enter your legal name (Example: Maxwell Smith). This is the student’s information (NOT parent). Be careful your computer doesn’t auto-fill the wrong information.

PERSONAL INFORMATION

- Enter your full name
- Enter your phone number/email address
- Select “**NO**” to opt out of texts about RRCC campus closures that do not affect classes on your high school campus
- Date of Birth (include birth year)
- Enter your mailing address
- Click “**Save & Continue**”

ACADEMIC INFORMATION

- Student Type:
 - “**No**” you are not a student at another college
 - “**No, I am a current high school student who will not graduate prior to the semester for which I am applying (aka concurrent enrollment).**”
- Academic Plans:
 - Select **Fall 2024** as the semester you will begin
 - Select “**TAKE COLLEGE COURSES WHILE I’M STILL IN HIGH SCHOOL**” as your current goal for community college.
 - Select: **An area of interest and degree that match the current pathway you are on.**
- Enter High School information:
 - Search for your **home high school** by name or the city it is located in and select it in the list

- When asked “Have you or will you earn a high school diploma or High School Equivalency?”, select “**YES**”
- Select your graduation month (May) and enter graduation year
- Click “**Save & Continue**”

RESIDENCY INFORMATION

**To complete all residency questions, please use the reverse side of this sheet to assist you.*

- Select your current citizenship status
- Enter your Social Security Number (no dashes!). **You MUST enter an SSN if you have one.** Only students who do not have an SSN can select a different status and leave it blank.
- Leave “**Under 23**” calculation unless incorrect
- When asked if you have attended a Colorado High School for 3 years, answer accordingly
 - If **YES**, select **YES**
 - If **NO**, answer according to application worksheet attached
- Click “**Save & Continue**”

- Answer questions regarding military duty and dependency
- Answer questions regarding gender
- Answer question regarding Ethnicity and Race
- Answer question regarding parent’s 4-year degree
- Answer question regarding your primary language
- Answer question regarding single parenthood
- Answer question regarding your status as an out-of-workforce individual
- Click “**Save & Continue**”

THE COLLEGE OPPORTUNITY FUND

**This is the state-paid portion of your tuition, which is a benefit to all Colorado residents. The COF application is free and can save you hundreds of dollars each semester on your tuition. Please note that if you do not apply for and authorize COF funding, you are responsible for both the student share and the state share of all tuition and fees.*

- Click “**YES**” to authorize Red Rocks to apply for the College Opportunity Fund stipend on your behalf. **This is REQUIRED to participate in Concurrent Enrollment.**
- Read and certify your application by clicking “yes”
- If under the age of 18, parent’s electronic signature is required.
- Sign and date your application
- Preview your info and make sure info is correct.
- Click “**Submit Application**”
- You will get a message that your Application has been submitted and issued a RRCC student ID number. When on your application account screen, refresh the page and look in the box near the bottom called “My Profile”. You should see your S# here!
