



High School Early Senior Achievement Scholarship Application

Deadline: Friday, December 6, 2024

The High School Early Senior Achievement Scholarship is for the high school student who has completed all of their high school graduation requirements by December of their Senior year, and wants a jump-start on their college education. This scholarship requires 6 to 12 credit hours of enrollment during each of the following three semesters: Spring 2025, Fall 2025, and Spring 2026. Notification of scholar selection will be sent via cccs email by December 13, 2024.

Eligibility Requirements

- Early graduation completion requirements by December 2024
Minimum *unweighted* high school GPA of 2.5 (on 4.0 scale)
- Colorado resident tuition classification (can be ASSET or a DACA recipient)
- Application for Admission to Red Rocks Community College
- U.S. citizen, or eligible non-citizen

Additional Guidelines

The scholarship application form along with the following information must be submitted to the Financial Aid Office by December 6, 2024

- Short essay (100-300 words), typed in an easy-to-read 12-point font
- Statement from high school counselor verifying the student is on track for early completion of all high school graduation requirements by December 2024. This letter must be on school letterhead, and be signed by the counselor.
- Copy of high school transcript as of the current semester

The scholarship will cover up to 12 college credits (tuition only) for three semesters (Spring 2025, Fall 2025, and Spring 2026). Registration fees, course fees, books and other educational expenses associated with the college courses are the responsibility of the student. Summer semester is optional, and must be pre-approved by RRCC's Scholarship Coordinator.

Registration Information

The following enrollment steps must be complete, prior to registering for classes:

- Apply for Admission to RRCC as well as the *College Opportunity Fund* (COF) state stipend -- www.rrcc.edu/admissions
- Complete the Assessment Process. Provide ACT or SAT test scores or take the ACCUPLACER assessment at RRCC.
- Meet with an Academic Advisor for course planning. Advising appointments can be scheduled via Navigate in The Rock, <https://www.rrcc.edu/advising/appointment>
